The Board has continued to be successful in resolution of complaints. The Board has not experienced any litigation or challenges during the last year.

The Board and industry continue to discuss the change in scope of practice to allow a podiatrist to practice above the foot to include the ankle area. Alabama is 1 of 2 states in the United States that does not allow its licensees this privilege. This is extremely important with recruiting new licensees to come to Alabama to practice Podiatry. Most graduates choose their practice locations based on this one privilege. We are not growing in licensees and do see this as a significant issue in the near future. There is a Legislative Committee that has drafted a bill that is currently in the Legislative Reference Service being draft to hopefully introduce during the 2015 Legislative Session.

The Board continues to operate through a Special Fund Account with a balance of \$77,112.21 as of December 31, 2014. Board revenue consists of license fees, license renewal fees, examination fees, administrative fines and/or penalties. The Board currently has 151 licensed podiatrists.
